## **FLOTILLA SPORTS COMPETITION 26 NOVEMBER 2017**

### **SITUATION**

RCSCC ILLUSTRIOUS will host the Flotilla Sports competition on 26 November 2016 at Bramalea Secondary School in Brampton, ON located at 510 Balmoral Dr, Brampton, ON L6T 1W4.

### **MISSION**

1. To promote physical activity and provide cadets of the local area the opportunity to participate in a fun day with a competitive aspect in friendly competition. The main goal of this event is for cadets from the participating units to have fun and find fellowship in the interaction between the corps.

### **EXECUTION**

#### 1. General Outline

- a. The competition will take place at Bramalea S. S. in Brampton.
- b. Escort Officers are responsible for the command, control and conduct of their cadets at all times.

#### 2. Timings

- a. **All participants will be at Bramalea Secondary School NLT than 0845 hrs 26 November 2016**
- b. Estimated departure time is 1620 hrs.
- c. An O-group will be held at 0845 to establish the order of competition and verify any questions concerning planning and regulations.

#### 4. Coordinating Instructions

- a. There will be three sports for each corps to prepare a team for:
  - i. Volleyball
  - ii. Basketball
  - iii. Flag Tag
- b. Refer to Appendix A for description and rules.
- c. Refer to Appendix B for detailed competition schedule and timings.

- d. Conducting Officers **must** be in possession of valid Ontario Health Cards for all their cadets.

## **SERVICE and SUPPORT**

1. Dress
  - a. Civilian Clothes for all personnel. Cadets are reminded to bring a water bottle and non-marking shoe soles.
2. Messing
  - a. Cadets are to bring their own snacks and lunches to the competition.
  - b. Cadets and officers are welcome to purchase from the canteen being provided by RCSCC Illustrious.
3. Transport
  - a. Each Corps is responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from the competition.
4. Medical Services
  - a. First Aid will be administered by qualified officers.
  - b. Emergency Medical Assistance will be provided by EMS.
  - c. In all cases, Brampton's William Osler Hospital will be available through ambulance via 9-1-1.
5. Support Personnel
  - a. Duty cadets will be provided by RCSCC ILLUSTRIOUS.
  - b. Conducting Officers must be prepared to assist or provide adult personnel to assist in various duties should there be a shortage in adult staff.
  - c. Canteen will be operated by RCSCC ILLUSTRIOUS.
6. Equipment
  - a. All required equipment will be provided by RCSCC ILLUSTRIOUS.

### Team make up

Each “team” is to consist of cadets from a variety of ages, phases, ranks and genders. This year it will be the responsibility of each unit to ensure a fair playing atmosphere for their cadets. The host unit 139 SEA will not be imposing rules about a minimum number of players per age or rank, however the OIC asks Corps to appoint Chiefs or senior cadets to act as coaches who will monitor the makeup of teams.

To allow the Phase 5 cadets the opportunity to lead and coach, it is requested that corps officers take a ‘hands off’ approach and cheer on their teams rather than coach.

### Volley Ball

- Six players on court
- FIVE serve maximum per player
- Server must be behind designated line
- No double hitting or lifting
- Ball may touch the net and still go over
- Point awarded when ball hits the ground regardless of serve
- Games will be played until one team reaches 15 points, but must win by 2 points
- Referee’s call stands

### Basket Ball

- Five players on court
- Regular basketball rules apply
- Games will be 10 minutes
- Rotations will be called by referee every 2-3mins
- Referee’s call stands

### Flag Tag (similar to capture the flag)

***Due to limited gym space Flag Tag will be played outdoors weather permitting.***

Set-up: Each player puts on a belt with 2 flags attached via Velcro.

Object: Keep your own flags while collecting opponent’s flags. Deposit opponent’s flags into your team’s hula-hoop/flag area. The team with the most people standing after 10min is the winner. For a tie the team with the most flags in play will win.

- Eight players on court per team
- Once a player loses both flags, they are out of play and can’t move
- Should a player loose their last flag while in possession of a flag from the other team, they must hand over that flag to the other team.
- Any player in play may pick up a dropped flag and a) take it to their designated flag area or b) give it to a player that is out to bring them back into the game
- Players may steal their flags back from the other teams flag area, if successful the flags may be used to bring players back into the game.
- Referee’s call stands
